



WHEN OCEANS THREATEN CITIES best audience of the year on France 5 - Science Grand Format, and a best-seller internationally

The documentary 1x90' and 1x52' directed by Laurence Thiriat and produced by Tangerine Production in co-production with Composite Films for France 5 - Science Grand Format was the best audience of the season for this slot. Aired on November 10th, it gathered more than 1,1million viewers on prime-time.

Distributed by Terranoa, the film was pre-sold to Ushuaia TV (France) and EarthxTV in the USA. The film has also gathered some 15 international buyers: SRC Canada, RTBF, VRT, SFDRS, RAI 3, RSI, TG4, Odisea, RTV Slovenia, TV Slovak, SRTV Romania, Ceska TV, TVP (Poland), EBS Korea.

This film examines the future of three coastal megacities, New York, Rotterdam and Singapore, which are threatened by rising sea levels and deadly storms. Engineers, architects, geographers and biologists test and implement hybrid solutions in a race against time.
