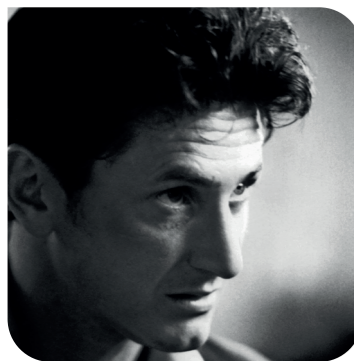

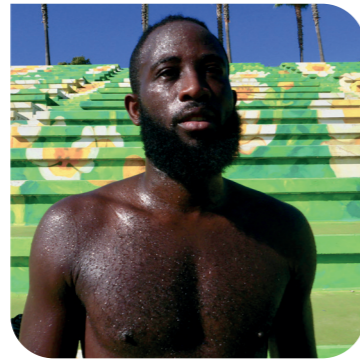

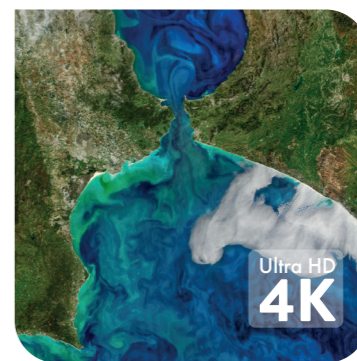


### SAVE THE BEARDED VULTURE
