Following step by step the daily routine of girls and boys aged from 6 to 10 is a fascinating and enlightening experience. Looking at things from their high and perspective opens up a new window on the world using a documentary style at once both fun and complicit with the children.

What does a Japanese child eat for breakfast in the countryside? Where do children sleep in the deserts of Morocco? Do they hug their parents when they wake up? What do Indians use to brush their teeth? How do Mexican boys and girls go to school? Is it just the English who wear a school uniform?

So many questions about everyday life, which highlight cultural difference. We can learn so much by peeking into these daily rituals.

The series unfolds around five essential morning activities : getting up / getting dressed / washing / having breakfast / going to school. We therethrough travel into different cultures and discover various social and cultural habits. By being very close to the children we are able to share their view of the world.
