

## MONACO GATE





On the 12th November, an examining magistrate put nine of the most powerful people of the Rocher into custody. The three main police officers, three commissioners, a former republican official, the former minister of justice of Monaco, his wife and his son and finally, the Russian billionaire Dmitry Rybolovlev, a close friend of Prince Albert and the owner of Monaco football club, and his lawyer, Tetiana Bersheda.
